



## Summer EBT is Now SUN Bucks

### Here's What You Need to Know

- Eligible families of school-age children will receive money, per child, to purchase groceries over the summer.
- Families will be automatically enrolled in SUN Bucks if they are already enrolled in SNAP, TANF, or FDPIR benefits or meet the requirements for free or reduced-price school meals.
- Qualifying groceries include fruits and vegetables, meat, poultry, fish, dairy products, breads, cereals, and non-alcoholic drinks.
- SUN Bucks can be spent [in-store](#) and [online](#).
- Funds will expire 122 days after issuance – so families are encouraged to use them sooner rather than later.
- Families can receive SUN Bucks on top of other nutrition benefits like SNAP and WIC.

Deadline(s): Families must apply by **April 15, 2025**, to be eligible for the first issuance of benefits in May. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until August 31, 2025.
