Handbook Updates for 25-26

As we begin the year, please take a moment to review a few important handbook updates:

School-Issued Chromebooks Only:

All students are expected to use a **school-issued Chromebook**. Personal devices from home may not be used during the school day.

In-Person Testing for Online Courses:

Students enrolled in online courses—including both KCHS and KCVA—must complete all assessments in person with our online learning classroom staff member.

Course Change Requests:

Requests to change courses must be submitted within the first two weeks of each semester. After this window, students will not be allowed to switch from an in-person course to an online one.

Cell Phones

To support focused, distraction-free classrooms, students are expected to keep their phones in their lockers throughout the school day. Phones may be checked briefly during passing time at the locker, but should not be brought to class.

If a student brings a phone to class, **teachers** are authorized to collect the device and turn it into the office. Repeated issues may result in additional consequences.

School Hours

Our regular school day runs from **7:55 AM to 2:50 PM**.

Doors open at 7:35 AM, and students are encouraged to arrive with enough time to **eat** breakfast and prepare for first hour.

While we will continue to offer a "second chance breakfast" between first and second hour, please note that options will be limited. Students should plan to eat breakfast before the school day begins to ensure they're fueled and ready to learn right from the start.
