
Students are selected by program instructors based on the characteristics of Going PRO (Professional, Respectful, and Ownership).

Fifty winners will be selected: 10 will receive \$50,000 and 40 will receive \$10,000, with funds placed in Michigan Education Savings Program accounts to cover educational expenses like tuition, textbooks, and living costs.
