END OF YEAR FIELD TRIPS

A \$100 fee has been added to each student's PowerSchool account for the end of year field trips. You can offset the cost of this field trip by selling candy bars. Any student who has sold candy bars so far will be credited for their sales. Candy bar sale guidelines are listed below. We hope that this fundraiser helps alleviate the cost of these trips for our student's and families.

End of the year trips will be on Friday, May 29, 2026.

- Each box costs \$60
- \$27 of this will automatically go towards their field trip, and the rest of the earnings you will keep to cover the cost of the box
- Each trip costs \$100. Students who sell four boxes will have their trips completely covered; students who sell fewer will only have to pay the remaining balance.
- Fundraising money can not be reimbursed for any reason. We also cannot accept any unsold candy bars back.
